

FOCUS ON 5 ESSENTIAL THINGS

The question Camp Araminta started with was "If a camper came for only one year, what five things would we want them to learn?" The answer became our guide for the structure of the discipleship program:

CREATION

I am made and loved by God

GOSPEL

Fall and redemption, life of Jesus

COMMUNITY

Where I fit in; my gifts and the Body of Christ

HOLINESS

Engaging the culture; discernment and cultural filters; how to be in the world

MISSION

Taking the Gospel into the world according to our gifts; telling others

Each year campers will be in a track that builds on the year before it and challenges them to grow further in their faith and Christian walk. After completing the mission track, the hope is that youth will transition into our Leader In Training (LIT) program with the ultimate goal of fostering strong Christian leaders.



FREQUENTLY-ASKED QUESTIONS

How much does camp cost?

The cost for camp this year is \$495/camper and \$395 for Leaders in Training.

Can I get financial assistance?

How do I register my child?

Registration is open now! Go to trinitythomasville.church for a direct link to the Ultracamp registration page.

What if my child requires medication?

A camp nurse will be on site for campers with first aid and/or medication needs. Any medications needed at camp should be brought in original prescription containers and turned in to the camp nurse at check in. Specific instructions should be provided as to dosage and scheduled delivery times. Under no circumstances should the child be permitted to self-medicate (this is required by law).

May I write to my child during the camp?

Absolutely! The camp registration website, Ultracamp, includes a service where parents may purchase a pack of digital "letters" that are printed daily and distributed to the campers just like "snail" mail. You can also mail a letter to your child at the address below.

Can I send care packages to my child?

Absolutely! We encourage you to do this as well. We do request that you avoid sending any discouraged items or excessive junk food. Please ensure that you allow adequate delivery time so that your package or letters don't arrive after your child has gone back home!

Should my child bring money to camp?

There will be a "Snack Shack" available for the children to purchase items such as sodas, snack foods, T-shirts, and other souvenirs that may interest them. We recommend bringing about \$10 to \$15 for the week. The camp will keep a record of the monies deposited upon registration so the children will not have to keep track of it throughout the week.
